



Yield to Worst (YTW): On a corporate bond, the yield to worst is the lowest yield that a buyer can expect among the reasonable alternatives, such as yield to maturity, yield to call, and yield to refunding.

Balanced Composite: The objective of this investment strategy is capital appreciation, with income generation an important, but secondary, goal. Balanced accounts are invested in equity and fixed income securities, including below investment grade (high yield) corporate bonds. The relative weighting between these security types will vary depending on available investment opportunities and market conditions. The allocation of equity investments in the portfolio will typically be lower than that of the Capital Appreciation account strategy. Key material risks include the risk that stock prices will decline and fixed income securities are subject to interest rate risk that could influence the value of investments. This composite is compared against a custom blended benchmark comprised of 60% Russell 3000 Value Index/ 30% ICE BofA 1-3 Year BB US Cash Pay High Yield Index / 10% ICE BAML 3-Month T-Bill Index for all periods presented. The custom benchmark is calculated by weighting the respective index returns on a monthly basis. The Balanced composite was created July 2016 and incepted January 2008.

Corbyn claims compliance with the Global Investment Performance Standards (GIPS®) and has prepared and presented this report in compliance with the GIPS standards. Corbyn has been independently verified for the periods January 1, 2008 through June 30, 2023. The verification report is available upon request.

Composite dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of annual gross returns of those portfolios included in the composite for the full year. The 3-year annualized standard deviation measures the variability of the composite gross returns and benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period. The investment management fee schedule for the composite is tiered at: first \$1mil 1.00%, next \$2mil 0.70%, and greater than \$3mil 0.50%. Actual investment fees incurred by clients are negotiable and may vary.
